In the West, some people believe that an individual's personality and character can be predicted according to the time of the year the person was born. From China comes the belief that the year of birth determines one's personality. In the past century, a relatively new belief has become popular: the idea that personality is related to one's ABO blood type. People with blood type A, for example, are considered more likely to be serious, hard-working, and quiet, (1) people with blood type O are likely to be popular and outgoing, yet often unable to finish what they start. Though this belief continues to be strong, researchers and critics question the accuracy of the theory, and warn of potential negative consequences.

The blood-type-personality theory started in Japan in 1927 when a high school administrator, Furukawa Takeji, observed personality similarities and differences among his workers. The theory soon went out of (2), but was brought back in force by a Japanese broadcaster named Toshitaka Nomi in the 1970s. The belief is still strong in Japan and is increasingly popular in neighboring countries. (3) Young South Koreans in particular have taken to the theory. *A Simple Thinking about Blood Type* is a popular South Korean webcomic with the blood-type-personality theory as its theme. It has been adapted and made into animations in Japan.

Ⅰ Is the belief accurate? Ⅱ The scientific community in Asia largely dismisses the belief as a modern-day superstition. Ⅲ Even when the occasional study comes along which claims to have found a link between blood type and personality traits, the differences are very small and often contradict the expected results of the blood-type theory. Ⅳ Psychologists generally warn against making predictions or important decisions based on (4) this questionable theory.

Tatsuya Sato, a psychology professor at Ritsumeikan University, claims, "Linking blood type and personality is not only unscientific, it's wrong." Critics like Sato warn that the blood-type-personality theory has created stereotypes that can have negative consequences, as we expect people to conform to a stereotype that might be untrue.

More serious are the reports that some Asian companies make hiring decisions based on blood types. One worker in a human resources company in China reported that clients often ask for blood-type information for job candidates, wanting only certain blood types for positions in their companies. In Japan, it is possible for companies to hire a "blood-type

consultant” to help with hiring decisions. Critics complain that if research is unable to prove any relationship between blood type and personality, can we justify hiring practices based on what might just be (5) ?
