The early Spanish explorers came to the New World in the 1500s in search of gold. Francisco de Coronado was one of these explorers. The story of Coronado is one of riches and adventure. In his quest for gold, Francisco de Coronado explored the American Southwest.

Coronado was born in Spain in 1510. In 1535, Coronado's friend Antonio de Mendoza became viceroy, the leader, of New Spain. New Spain included much of what is today Mexico. Coronado traveled with his friend to New Spain and worked as Mendoza's assistant. After his arrival in New Spain, Coronado became an important man. He married Beatriz Estrada, the daughter of a wealthy man. This marriage made Coronado very rich. Coronado's power grew, and he became governor of one of the provinces.

After some time, Mendoza (1) { A. lead B. a C. asked D. for E. Coronado F. to G. search } seven legendary cities. These cities were called the "Seven Cities of Cibola." People believed that these cities had streets made of gold. Stories also told of tall houses with doors decorated with jewels.

In 1540, Coronado took 1,400 men with him to search for these treasures. He also took horses for the troops to ride and sheep, cattle, and pigs to feed the men. The explorers searched in what is now the American Southwest. They crossed mountains and found a Native American *pueblo* or village. The Native Americans were *the Zuni tribe.

Ⅰ When Coronado found the Zuni pueblo, he found something very unusual. Ⅱ The Zuni built their homes this way to protect them, but this was not enough to protect the Zuni people from the men on horses and their guns. Ⅲ Coronado captured the Zuni pueblo. Ⅳ The treasure hunters did not find any gold, so they (2) looking. They captured and searched other nearby villages but found nothing.

The explorers still did not give up. Coronado sent a small group of men west and another group north. Both groups returned with stories of deep canyons but without gold. Eventually, Coronado realized that the seven cities were probably not real cities, only a (3) .

After two years, Coronado and some of his men returned to New Spain. Coronado told Mendoza that he had not found any gold. Mendoza was angry and (4) called Coronado a failure. A court tried Coronado for his failure. They found him innocent of the charges. He returned to his role of governor. Later (5) Coronado was tried again. This time the charges were cruelty

and dishonesty. The court found him guilty, and Coronado was removed from office. He died that same year in 1544.

Many people thought that Coronado's search for treasure failed, but he and his men found something more important than gold. The men who did not return with Coronado became the first Spanish settlers of the American Southwest. The land he and his men explored is different from other places in the world. The explorers did not find the gold they were looking for. (7), they found natural treasures like the Grand Canyon and Monument Valley.
